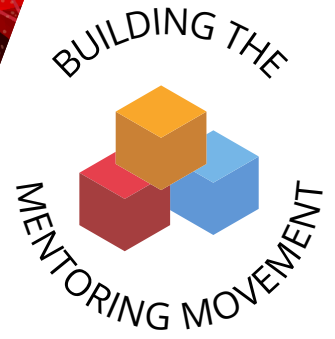

PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT - Site-specific opportunities that range from a single session to longer-term projects curated to address your organizational or programmatic needs. Customized plans may include: staff/teacher training sessions, population-specific supports, or match recruitment assessment.

CONSULTATION - MMP can support your school in assessing readiness to start a mentoring program, provide technical assistance throughout the planning and design process, and ultimately develop a mentoring program to meet your specific needs. Mentoring models may include: partner program collaboration for group or individual mentoring, speed mentoring events, or a Success Mentoring Program.

YOUTH CENTRIC EVENTS AND TRAININGS - Work with MMP to create a customized training plan or event, offering support to your students engaging in youth-initiated mentoring. Plans can be designed with the goal of developing students' knowledge, skills, and ability to develop their own social networks.

ENHANCING COLLEGE /CAREER READINESS AND YOUTH WORK PROGRAMS - Work with MMP to ensure your workforce development and/or career/college readiness program is designed for student success. Create a customized plan to engage your participants while focusing on a Relationship-centered approach. Plans may include one or more of the following: training for students, training for supervisors/mentors, training for college/career coaches.
